Hosting a Drive

Your donation drive will help to make sure that every child who stays at our Sanctuary has shoes, clothing, a new duffel bag, and an opportunity to participate in engaging activities.

Step 1: Decide Your Drive Details

- **What are the dates** of your drive? How long will it last? *Although holidays are a popular time for a donation drive, the Emergency Sanctuary is always in need of your support!*
- **What will you collect?**

We always welcome donations of:

- New, unopened packages of socks in all sizes (toddler to 12)
- New, unopened packages of underwear in all sizes (toddler to 12)
- New backpacks and duffel bags, all colors and sizes, especially gender-neutral styles
